ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

In 1974-75 the University of Sindh with its solitary campus in Jamshoro, could not keep pace with the growing need of the SindhProvince for higher education. Another campus was therefore set up at Khairpur Mir's named after the great international poet of Sindh, Shah Abdul Latif Bhitai. The campus was meant to provide higher education facilities in various modern and scientific fields to the people in the northern part of the Province of Sindh, which had a rich tradition of producing highly educated and intelligent people.

On 16th March, 1986, the Sindh provincial assembly passed an act to make the campus a full-fledged and independent university. The act came into force in 1987, making the university functional, under the then Chief Minister. Its campus covers an area of 307 acres of lush green lawns, playgrounds and trees. The landscape includes three canals nearby which serve as picnic spots for the students and the faculty.

ShahAbdulLatifUniversity, Khairpur is located in the heartland of Upper Sindh, i.e. Khairpur, a former state that joined Pakistan in 1955. The main campus is located near National Highway and is easily reachable by Air, Railway & Bus services. The SukkurAirport, is one of the biggest Airports of Upper Sindh, is on half an hour drive and Khairpur Railway station is 5kms away from the main campus.

The beauty of Shah Abdul Latif University, Khairpur lies in the fact that it is surrounded by famous Archaeological Sites: MohenjoDaro, KotDijiFort, Rohri Hills, Nara Desert, religious shrines of Sadhu Bello, Shrine of HazratSachalSarmast, barrages and bridges (Lloyds Barrage and Lanes Down) and Oil & Gas Fields (OMV, Sawan Field &KadanWari).

Ghotki Campus

In line with the policies of Higher Education Commission Pakistan to provide quality education to the people at their door step, Ghotki Campus has been established in the old block of the Government Boys' Degree College Ghotki. In this regard, Govt: of Sindh supported generously support of Govt. of Sindh

Initially HEC has earmarked Rs: 10 Million as an operational cost. The former Chief Minister Sindh and MNA Sardar Ali Muhammad Khan Mahar and Prof. Dr. Parveen Shah inaugurated the campus by unveiling the plaque. In its first phase, three departments such as Department of English, Department of Business Administration and Department of Computer Science & I.T have been started. This Campus will cater the academic need of the people of Ghotki District.





At the end, the trophies and shields were distributed among the winners and runners teams.







Gender- wise detail

- ❖ Academic Council decides the Academic matters and passes the Regulation pertaining to Academic matters.
- ❖ Advance Studies & Research Board approves of the research proposals and recommends the award of PhD and MS/MPhil degrees.
- **Selection Board** recommends the suitable candidates to the Syndicate for appointments.
- ❖ Finance & Planning Committee is responsible to put forward the Budget proposals to the Syndicate for final approval.
