An Orientation Session on National Freelance Training Program (NFTP) was held jointly organized by the Punjab Information Technology Board (PITB) and SALU. Prof. Dr. Taj Muhammad Lashari, Dean Faculty of Social Sciences presided the session.

Prof. Dr. Taj Muhammad Lashari said this training will impart the youth to get the knowledge about to start their earnings through freelancing. He remarked that in this cyber age, there are number of opportunities for youth. The technology refers to adaptation of new methods in our daily life. Through freelancing earning, the social status of the youth will be enhanced. Prof. Dr. Naveed Ahmed Shaikh said it is part of linkage. He said technology boom has changed the mindset of the youth. Technology is the main source of earning. He advised the youth to use the technology in positive manner. Dr. Shaikh said producer and consumer are wealth oriented behavior.

Mr. Chaudhry Ahmed Islam, Joint Director Freelancing Projects PITB said we have trained more than 60,000 youth as result, they earned Rs. 3.63 Million income since 2017 to date. Especially women remained beneficiary. He quoted

the case study of Bangladesh where 44 Billion Dollars were earned through freelancing. He said we are working with the Ministry of Telecommunication. Currently, we have established 5 Training Centers in Sindh where more than 2000 students were trained. 500 students earned 9 Lac rupees.

Ms. Resham Jamshed, Regional Manager PITB briefed about Erozgar. She said Erozgar has been successfully working in Punjab. We will start three months course at Shah Abdul Latif University, Khairpur. The outlines regarding freelancing will be provided and five-day classes will be conducted.

Ms. Shahida Amir Chandio, Incharge Department of Political Science said this is a good initiative taken by the PITB. The Trainers will train the female students also. This will provide an earning opportunity. She said this program will also enhance the Interprovincial Harmony through strong linkages.

He said I am optimistic that under the Higher Education opportunities in US, the Faculty Members and Students will be benefited.

Prof. Dr. Naveed Ahmed Shaikh, Director Postgraduate Studies and Focal Person briefed the milestone achieved by the University and also briefed the delegation regarding different research programs and projects embarked by the University.

Wayne State University established in 1868 having 27000 students. Students from 80 countries are getting their education. The University has 350 degree programs. The University is trying to encourage the exchange of students and to promote interdisciplinary research with global community.

Ms. Xinyo talked on Global Engagement and Partnership regarding International Students Programs at Michigan State University. She said it is a global University promoting civic education, rule of law and working on indigenous issues. It is top of among 100 Universities of world having 200 academic programs. She said that the thematic research is being conducted on 39 programs i.e food and agriculture, education and learning, health and nutrition, environment and energy. She revealed that currently we are embarking two research projects in Pakistan on interfaith community building and women leadership in higher education in Punjab province. She said that the purpose of visit at Shah Abdul Latif University, Khairpur aimed at to capacity building, trainings, research projects, visit of scholars and students and faculty, students exchange.

Dr. Brittany Afolter said that Michigan State University is working on University Research Corridor Cluster. The purpose is to share the advance knowledge at global level and increasing prosperity and connecting the Michigan State University to world.

KASHMIR SOLIDARITY DAY COMMEMORATED

He said that the continuous repressive and aggressive policies and atrocities committed by the Indian Forces has created extensive difficulties in the Occupy Kashmir. He said the plight of Kashmiri people is miserable. Pakistan Government has pleaded this case on different international forums i.e. United Nations, O.I.C, SAARC to end the hostile attitude of so called Indian government. He lamented that siege and search operation is continue in the occupied valley. Dr. Lashari appreciated the role of civil and military leadership for highlighting the Kashmir case on diplomatic and political fronts globally. The stance of Government of Pakistan is that this issue shall be resolved through composite dialogue in peaceful manner.

Dr. Siraj Ahmed Soomro, Chairman Department of Pakistan Studies highlighted in his address the core issue of Kashmir and its genuineness. He said it is long struggle of Kashmiri people. The United Nations under the influence of great powers has not yet resolved the Kashmir issue.

Ms. Shahida Amir Chandio, Incharge Department of Political Science shed light on the human rights abuses committed by the Indian Forces in the Occupied Valley She said the right of self determination of Kashmiri people is universal and fundamental right but the India has denied.

The Declamation Contest on the theme: The Right of Self Determination and the Role of Government of Pakistan in Highlighting the Kashmir Case at various International Forums" was also held. Mr. Aftab Ahmed, Mr. Waqar Ahmed, Mr. Asad Abbas, Mr. Asif Abro and Mr. Deep Rajput delivered their speeches on the theme. They said that the Government of Pakistan has rightly pleaded the case of Kashmiri people in international forums vocally but the hegemonic design of India in the region has denied their right of self determination. They stressed the need that world community may come forward to resolve this issue in a way of pacific settlement.

The certificates and prizes were distributed among the speakers. A Solidarity Rally was also taken out in the campus premises. The participants chanted the slogans in the favor of right of self determination of Kashmiri people.

She said that the aim of present study was to analyze the level of trace and toxic elements such as Iron, Copper, Cadium, Chromium and Arsenic in five different fish species cultivated in five various ponds of the Taluka.

The second seminar was defended by Ph. D Research Scholar Mr. Atta Hussain Rind on the topic "Evaluation and Human Health Risk Assessment of Toxic Elements Exposure in Water Agriculture Soils and Vegetables of Selected Areas of Sindh" under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Mushtaque Ali Jakhrani. He said that the aim of the

present study was to establish the various factors such as the minimum, maximum and average level of contaminants in 15 popular green vegetables cultivated in four districts i.e. Ghotki, Shikarpur, Kashmore and Larkana.

Speaking on this occasion, Prof. Dr. Khalil Ahmed Ibupoto said that the research work of the both scholars is related with the fish and vegetables. The research work has direct relevance with the community and main source of earning and food product.





CELEBRATION OF PAKISTAN DAY

On the directives of the Vice Chancellor the Pakistan Day was celebrated. A One-Day Seminar was organized by the Departments of Political Science, Pakistan Studies in collaboration with Young Peace Development Corps (YPDC) on the topic "Lahore Resolution: Context and Significance." Prof. Dr. Taj Muhammad Lashari, Dean Faculty of Social Sciences presided over the seminar while Prof. Dr. Farman Ali Mangi, Chairman Department of Physics, Ms. Shahida Amir Chandio, Incharge Department of Political Science and Dr. Inayatullah Bhatti, Department of Pakistan Studies and Advocate Shafqat Ali Maitlo were the guests of honor.

Prof. Dr. Taj Muhammad Lashari said that the Lahore Resolution 1940 was a hallmark development in the establishment of Pakistan. It provided a base for separate homeland for Muslims in the Sub-Continent. Lahore Resolution is a prime document in the struggle of Pakistan. Dr. Lashari said it is our collective responsibility to strengthen the state in terms of education, economic stability and to provide peaceful and conducive environment based on tolerance and promotion of inclusive society.

Prof. Dr. Farman Ali Mangi said Muslims were under the dominant rule of British Raj and Muslims were deprived from their basic rights. He quoted the example of plights of the Muslims in Occupied Valley of Kashmir who are deprived from their right of independence.

Dr. Inayatullah Bhatti said that this day is being commemorated in order to apprised the youth regarding the importance of Pakistan Day. He said this day is not less than 14th August. The Muslims in the advent of British Raj were facing numerous threats, despite their atrocities, they continued their struggle for the establishment of separate homeland in the shape of Pakistan. Ms. Shahida Amir Chandio said the Lahore Resolution is alive historic document. Prior 1940 the struggle of Muslims was for the attaining of rights and constitutional reforms but after 1940 resolution, their struggle got momentum for separate country.

Advocate Shafqat Ali Maitlo said basically 23rd March 1940 provided a voice to the Muslims. He said at this juncture the enemies of Pakistan are engaged to sabotage the peace and prosperity of Pakistan. We have to eliminate such evil forces. Our armed forces are protecting the national borders with commitment day and night. With unity and strength, we could establish prosperous and developed Pakistan in the comity of the nations.
